The following information covers the arrangements we have made for the upcoming HMM 362 Archie's Angels / Ugly Angels Reunion in Tulsa Oklahoma. This reunion will take place on 10, 11 and 12 October 2003. That is a Friday, Saturday and Sunday, this coming October. The reunion will be hosted by Mr. Gerald Hail and the YL 37 Group, of Inola, Oklahoma. You may recall that this man and the group he founded fully restored one of the combat aircraft HMM 362 used during the Vietnam war.

Accommodations may be reserved by you with The Embassy Suites, in Tulsa, Oklahoma. We have negotiated what we believe is a good deal for us all. Guest suites will cost \$ 89.00 per night. Each guest suite includes a private bedroom and separate living room. A king size or two double beds in each bedroom and a pullout double bed in each living room.
